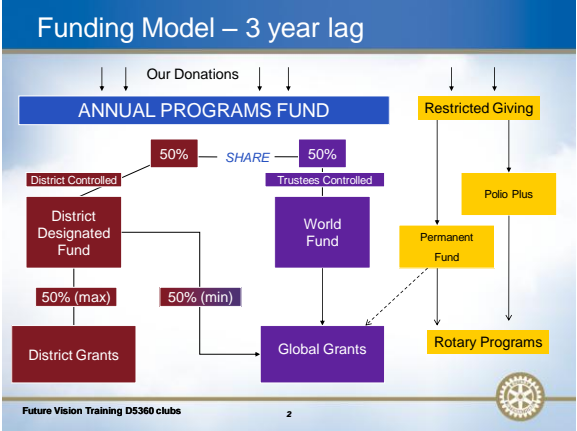


## District Designated Funds supporting Global Project Grants

### Global Project Grant overview

- Involves Foreign club in **PILOT** District
- Six areas of focus
- TRF provides minimum USD 15,000
- TRF matches club funds by 50%
- TRF matches DDF by 100%
- DDF managed by District Grants Committee or DGC

### 5360 - District Designated Funds – 2011/2012

- DDF for Global Projects ~ **\$80,000**
- Max DDF per project ~ \$5,000
- Funds held by TRF, accessible only with Global Grant application
- Need key District signatures approving

				<b>\$40,000</b>

\* Must be at least 15,000

- Apply to District for DDF
- Once approved, submit TRF Proposal
- Once approved, submit TRF Application
- Do project
- Once complete, submit Final Report
- On-line via Member Access

### DDF Application – Quick & Easy

- Have a project description & budget
- Have a partner
- Have Board approval for your share
- Your club is “project lead”
- Valid 12 months
- Max USD5,000 per project,
- One application per club.

### Other details for DDF application

- Club must contribute USD 5,000 min.
- Evaluated by 3 person committee
- Response in 2-3 weeks
- Apply for DDF before online Global Grant application
- First come –first served basis
