



- Max Grant \$2,000
- Club must contribute an additional 50%
- Combined Maximum Total = \$3,000



- Supports post secondary study, including university, trade schools, technical schools.
- Clubs establish eligibility criteria.
- Club committee selects recipient(s).
- Scholarships should be paid to post-secondary institution and not the student, if at all possible.



- No minimum amounts Clubs may award more than one scholarship from each grant received & determine the amount of each scholarship.
- Pooling between clubs is allowed to establish a larger scholarship – separate applications from each club are required. Only one pooled application per club allowed out of all its district grant applications for VTT, Youth Programs, Scholarships and Projects.



- Maximum number of applications is two;
- Club must "prioritize" applications as #1 or #2, when submitting more than one;
- #2 applications will only be considered after satisfying all eligible #1 applications;
- FAILURE TO CLEARLY PRIORITIZE APPLICATIONS WILL RESULT IN BOTH APPLICATIONS BEING DISQUALIFIED.
