- Preference for New Program of Study
- Must have a host Rotary Club or District in the country where the study takes place
- Must be a resident of D5360
- Ineligible: Rotarians and their descendants and/or ancestors

Typical Successful Candidates: 5-7 years experience in peace-related field




Application Process:
