

Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) Requirements & Club Qualification



Qualification

- Districts must qualify to receive TRF funds District Designated Funds - DDF
- District signs an MOU with TRF

 Ensures proper governance for grants
 Covers District & Global Grants
- Clubs sign MOU with the District to qualify
 Clubs must report on the use of DDF
- TRF can audit District



Club Qualification Requirements

- Participate in Club Qualification seminar
 Minimum 1 person **every** year
- Club Board agrees to MOU requirements
- Club PE & President Nominee sign MOU
- Club sends MOU to District
 - MOU is uploaded onto District 5360 Grants
 Website <u>www.rotary5360.org</u> by May 1, 2018



Why a Club MOU?

- Legal Agreement club with District
- D5360 Club responsibilities
 Implementing Global Grants
 - Bank accounts for each project
 - Usually in host country
 - Implementing District Grants
 - Separate bank account not required



1 - Club Qualification

- Must be done annually
- Must comply with MOU
- Club responsible for grant funds
- Qualification may be suspended for violating terms
- Club cooperates with all audits



2 - Club Officer Responsibilities

- Appoint a club member to manage club qualification
- Ensure grant management practices are implemented
- Ensure all individuals involved in grant avoid conflicts of interest

Club may be required to pay back all grants if the project is not completed or reports are not done satisfactorily

- Signed on behalf of club Directors

 - 2017-18 President Nominee
 Serving as President in 2019-20
