

Vocational Training Team (VTT) Grants



What Is a Vocational Training Team (VTT)?

- A group of professionals who travel to another country to
 - 1. Learn more about their profession, or
 - 2. Teach local professionals about a particular field
- Travel can be in either or both directions
- Grants can support more than one team
- Teams can include non-Rotarians



Two Types of VTT Grants

- District Grants: <u>www.rotary5360.org</u>
- Global Grants: <u>https://grants.rotary.org</u>
- VTT can be embedded in a global grant
- A global grant with an embedded VTT qualifies for an extra \$5,000 DDF.



Travel Requirements for VTTs

• Must first conduct a community assessment, and include results in your application – *New!*

<u>Community Assessment Tools</u> are available in the Rotary International Grant Center

- Travel arranged by the team members or organizer
- VTT team must have travel insurance Medical personnel practicing medicine must have additional insurance



District VTT Grants

- Team with relevant experience, preferably led by Rotarian
- Co-operating organizations are permitted Does not have to involve another Rotary club
- Any country except those barred by TRF
- Training may be in Canada
- Must support RI Areas of Focus



2018-19 District Grants for VTTs

- Maximum Award is \$7500
- Club contribution is 1/3 of Award
- One grant application per club
- Pooling by clubs is permitted
 - Multiple clubs may apply for the same VTT and pool the funds

Only one pooled grant application per club allowed out of all its district grant applications for VTT, Youth Programs, Scholarships and Projects



VTT Global Grants

• Must satisfy all GG requirements

Support one or more of Rotary's Areas of Focus Requires international host Rotary Club or District Must request at least \$US15,000 match from TRF

• Team consists of 2 or more persons <u>plus</u> a Rotarian leader with relevant expertise
